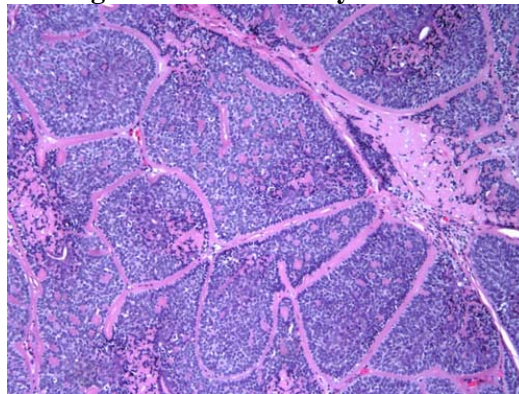

**Jigsaw Pattern of a Cylindroma**




### **GROSS DESCRIPTION:**

Labeled with the patient's name and designated SCALP, received in formalin is a 1 x 1 x 1cm circular uniform skin punch, submitted in 1 cassette.

### **MICROSCOPIC DESCRIPTION:**

Variously-sized, crowded, discrete aggregations of epithelial cells, some of which contain tubules are surrounded by rims of homogeneous eosinophilic material.
